4. High-Performance Deployment Checklist

- Step A: Verify sender authorization and character length restrictions (max 11 characters).
- Step B: Test message rendering on feature phones, iOS, and Android to detect encoding issues.
- Step C: Schedule large audience dispatches (>10,000) through the background queue worker.
- Step D: Embed short trackable URLs to analyze click-through rates and customer conversions.

5. Quality Assurance & Error Mitigation

Avoid generic spam language or misleading offers that trigger automated telco firewalls.

When sending time-sensitive notices, maintain active dual credit balances (non-expiry backup).

RECOMMENDED: Use the automated Cron Worker for 1M recipient campaigns to bypass timeouts.
